	Original and review articles: not exceed 30, Case reports: 20 manuscript pages, with the abstract, references, figures, and tables. Letters and rapid communications: less than 4 manuscript pages.
Manuscript text file includes:	
	Cover page includes the type of the article (e.g., Original article, Case report, Review article, etc), the title, the full names of the authors, the authors' academic affiliations, the mailing address of the corresponding author, including a telephone number, fax number, e-mail address, and the numbers of text pages, figure legends, tables and figures. It should be also contain 3-5 Keywords.
	Abstract maximum 200 words for original and review articles, and 75 words for case reports.
	Main body of the text: Divide into the sections (such as Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, and Discussion, etc).
	Acknowledgments
	Conflict of interest: (Essential: See below)
	References: Number consecutively in the order cited in the text, not alphabetically.
	Tables: Each table must be on a separate page. Major abbreviations must be explained in footnotes.
	Figures: Must be submitted separately from manuscript text file. Label as original or with details of their source. GIF, JPEG, EPS and TIFF format are supported. Please avoid uploading PPT files.

	If yes, please disclose and declare in the Conflict of Interest section in the manuscript any such financial and personal relationships between any author and any company whose product or competing product plays a prominent role in the subject of the manuscript.
	If no, please declare it in the Conflict of Interest section that none exist.
